


OUR ROAD. *MANY TRIPS*



Pennsylvania Route 6

Who knew the American Dream was down the road?

All across US Route 6 in Pennsylvania, you will find snippets of the real America as well as true scenic beauty. Below are suggestions for a long weekend or you can piece all three trips together for a longer week drive across “One of America’s favorite scenic drives.”

CRAWFORD LAKELANDS BYWAY

Mile Marker 0-38

Feed the ducks as they walk across the carp’s back at the Linesville Spillway & Pymatuning State Park.

Enjoy the view from Conneaut Lake from the shoreline or on a Barbara J cruise.

Browse around the Meadville Markethouse.

Taste the local food and drink at Conneaut Lake Winery and Distillery, Voodoo Brewing, Lago Winery and Brew Pub, or Sprague Farm & Brew Works.

Stay at a hotels in Meadville or venture east to one of the last standing mineral springs resorts in Pennsylvania – the Riverside Inn.

KINZUA COUNTRY

Mile Marker: 124 to 159

Start in the city of Bradford, by exploring the history of the Zippo Lighter, Case knives and the exploration for oil at the Penn Brad Museum.

Marvel at the Kinzua Dam and the Allegheny Reservoir before touring down the Longhouse Scenic Drive through the Allegheny National Forest.

Taste the local flavors in Kane at either CJ Spirits or Flickerwood Winery.

“Walk the Tracks Across the Sky” - the Kinzua Skywalk in Mt. Jewett.

Follow the walking tour through the Smethport Mansion District. Stay the night in one of the B&B’s or Inns in Smethport or Port Allegany.

GOVERNOR CASEY BYWAY

Mile Marker: 328-345

Walk the Northern Electric Trolley Trail in Clark Summit.

Follow the signs into Scranton to Steamtown National Park Site, which is dedicated to the history of the steam locomotive, and the Electric Trolley Museum.

Go deep inside the Lackawanna Coal Mine.

Taste the ethical foods from Scranton’s European immigrant past.

Explore the walking tour of Carbondale.

Stay in one of the many accommodations in Scranton or Carbondale.
