2 Days / 1 Night

DAY 1

10:00 am – Arrive in London, Ontario!

FANSHAW PIONEER VILLAGE – Experience the living history of London and see weavers, printmakers, blacksmiths and farmers demonstrate their trades of the past.

12:00 noon – Lunch

1:00 pm

ROYAL CANADIAN REGIMENT MUSEUM – See the history of the Royal Canadian Regiment through medals, photographs, weapons, films and uniforms. Military souvenir shop sells stamps, caps, shirts and books about the Regiment.

2:30 pm

BANTING HOUSE NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE – This museum is located in the house where Sir Frederick G. Banting lived and practiced medicine until the early 1920s. Artifacts and displays tell the story of the discovery of insulin and of the nature of medicine in Banting's time. Outside the Flame of Hope burns for diabetics around the world. The flame was lit by the late Queen Mother in the summer of 1989 and will burn continuously until a cure is found.

3:30 pm

ELDON HOUSE – London's oldest house built in 1834, is now an historical museum complete with all the heirlooms and furnishings of the period.
