Stop 1 – Geese In Flight - [Click here to view it in 360°](#)

The World's Largest Scrap Metal Sculpture, listed in the Guinness Book, it stands 110 feet tall, 150 feet wide and weighs 78.8 tons with over five miles of welding. The center opening of the sculpture measures is over 32 feet wide!

This massive sculpture invokes a process called shadowing showcasing musculature of the deer in the right light. It was so large, that it had to be cut apart to move through town before putting it in place!

In honor of the landowner who tragically passed before completion of this sculpture, Grasshoppers was illuminated at night for several years after its construction.

Dry conditions during construction resulted in a prairie fire that thankfully was quickly extinguished. The responding fire department commented that this could have been the World's Largest Fish Fry!

Commemorating one of North Dakota's best game birds, these massive pheasants had to be cut in half to be transported to the site!
