Day 1: Arrive mid-day in Sevierville and enjoy new, affordable lodging options – Sevierville has more than 4,000 rooms available.

Begin your Smoky Mountain visit with adventure. Sign up for a **zip line excursion** through the foothills or go **white water rafting** on the Pigeon River's Class III and IV rapids. Outdoor enthusiasts will also enjoy fishing on the area's lakes and mountain streams.

For dinner, try a taste of downhome barbecue at **Tony Gore's Smoky Mountain BBQ & Grill**. After dinner, visit one of the city's distilleries, including **Old Tennessee Distilling Co.** for a sip of White Lightnin', better known as moonshine. Then make a stop at **Sevier Distilling Co.** to taste a pure distilled honey liquor. This one-of-a-kind spirit is called Yenoh and is only made right here in Sevierville, TN.



Day 2: Fuel up with a hearty breakfast at **Flapjack's Pancake Cabin**. Then head **down-town Sevierville** for a photo with the bronze statue of Sevierville's own Dolly Parton, located on the lawn of the Sevier County Courthouse.

Depart for **Great Smoky Mountains National Park** and gain important insights into the park's significance with a stop at **Sugarlands Visitor Center**. There you'll visit the nature museum and view an informative film about the park before you begin to explore more than 800 miles of maintained hiking trails.

For dinner, enjoy southern cooking at its finest at **Applewood Farmhouse Restaurant**. This historic farmhouse is located on a working apple orchard and serves up southern cooking. After dinner, stroll through the **Apple Barn Complex** where you can watch cooks frying apple pies, candy makers drawing taffy and vintners creating fruit wines at **Apple Barn Winery** (one of three wineries in Sevierville).

Tonight, see a baseball game at **Tennessee Smokies Stadium** where the home team is the AA affiliate of the 2016 World Championship Series Chicago Cubs.

Day 3: Depart for **Dollywood**, named for Sevierville's hometown girl, Dolly Parton. Spend the day enjoying live entertainment (over 40 live shows performed daily), award-winning thrill rides, delicious meals, shopping, authentic mountain craft demonstrations and more.
