For a few glorious weeks, autumn crowns the Smoky Mountains with spectacular color. This year, enjoy memorable Harvest Fest activities and the best fall views of all: your own. Day 1: Arrive mid-day in Sevierville and enjoy new, affordable lodging options. Choose to go glamping (glamorous camping), rent a luxurious cabin or stay at a family-friendly indoor water park resort. Then enjoy the smells of autumn when you visit the Apple Barn & Cider Mill. Watch as fried apple pies, old fashioned stick candy and delicious apple wines are made before your eyes. Then shops around the village and enjoy views of the orchard. Enjoy dinner at Applewood Farmhouse Restaurant where each hearty meal begins with fresh apple fritters and (non-alcoholic) Applewood Julep.



Day 2: Fuel up with a hearty breakfast at Flapjack's Pancake Cabin. Then choose among Sevierville's three self-guided fall driving tours for a leisurely backroad trip highlighted by historic sites and great views. Those who choose the **English Mountain Fall Driving Tour** will travel a picturesque route to the Bush Beans Visitor Center and can enjoy lunch at Bush's Café.

Spend the afternoon and evening in historic downtown Sevierville and snap a photo the bronze statue of Dolly Parton, which is located on the lawn of the Sevier County Courthouse. If it's a Saturday night in October, stick around for **History & Haunts**. This new event takes place from 5pm until 9pm each Saturday evening and features live music, family-friendly events, guided historic walking tours and more. Guests can enjoy a variety of other **fall themed events** as well from September through October. Stick around for dinner, too. Graze Burgers serves up natural grass-fed beef and foot long hotdogs in a historic Sevierville building (it was the town's first post office). Some team is the AA affiliate of the 2016 World Championship Series Chicago Cubs.

Day 3: Discover **adventurous ways to view fall leaves**. From taking in the scenery while riding a zip line to hovering above it all with Scenic Helicopter Tours, there are more ways to enjoy fall color than simply driving through it. Plan a hike in Great Smoky Mountains National Park, America's most visited national park, and enjoy the crisp mountain air and breathtaking views. Later that day, schedule time for shopping in Sevierville – the shopping capital of the Smokies.
