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## Day 1 - Starkville

Your trip begins in Starkville, the home of Mississippi State University and one of Mississippi's culinary rising stars, Two Brothers Smoked Meats. The restaurant, located in Starkville's Cotton District, serves a variety of slow-cooked meats, including street tacos, sandwiches, and burgers. Look for the building with the two-story bright blue and purple mural.



## Day 2 - Metro Jackson

Metro Jackson is known for the quality and variety of its restaurants. One of the city's new culinary hotspots is Elvie's, where you'll find a cozy New Orleans-inspired dining experience with an emphasis on fresh, locally sourced ingredients. The restaurant is located in the heart of Jackson's historic Belhaven neighborhood.

## Day 3 - Hattiesburg

Hattiesburg is home to one of Mississippi's best-known culinary entrepreneurs, Robert St. John. You really can't go wrong with any of St. John's establishments, which include Crescent City Grill, Tabella, and Ed's Burger Joint. One of his latest ventures, The Midtowner, serves traditional breakfast favorites and blue-plate lunches seven days a week.

Their fixed-price, multi-course tasting menu changes almost daily and emphasizes seasonality, sustainability, and locally-sourced ingredients.
