Battle of Camp Wildcat

Though the armies have long since disappeared, many of their trenches remain as reminders of what happened on that October day. If you visit the battlefield and stand quietly behind the trenches you may feel your heart begin to pound just like the soldiers' hearts pounded in 1861.

The battlefield looks much different from the etchings made in 1861. Most of it has been logged-over several times. A few trails lead to the faint outlines of old trenches that remain.

The remoteness of location of this battle makes it unique, because you can still see these trenches. Battlefield sites located in gentler terrain were farmed over and developed, destroying signs of the battle.

McHargues Mill visitors can view over 100 hand-chiseled Library of Mountain Millstones lining the paths around the gristmill. Its the largest collection of millstones outside the Smithsonian Institution. The Mill stands inside the entrance to the 896-acre Levi Jackson Wilderness Road Park in Laurel County. The mill was moved from Robinson Creek to its current location in 1939, which was operated as a State Park until September 2019, when it was transferred to the city of London.

Sanders Cafe and Museum joined the National Register of Historic Places on July 5, 1990, constructed in the summer of 1940, in southern Laurel County. The frame cafe was once part of the Sanders Motor Court and Cafe. It was in this cafe that Colonel Harland Sanders developed and initiated the franchising of his fried chicken which made his name a household word in America. Located at 688 Hwy 25 in southern Laurel County in Corbin, KY began a massive interior and exterior restoration project in 2019. Completed in April 2022, restaurant now features a unique and world-class design that preserves the historical integrity with design elements drawn from KFCs signature American Showman design aesthetic, which pays tribute to Colonel Sanders.
