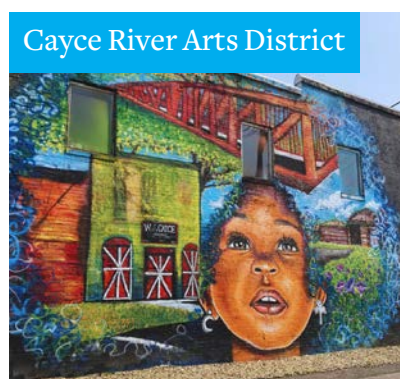
5:00 PM - Relaxation and Reflection
