Continue your journey up the county searching for [barn quilts](#) along the highway and back roads, each one with a unique story. Then, make a stop at the famous [Calvert Cliffs State Park](#) to scan the beach for fossils and shark teeth.

As you cruise through Prince Frederick Town Center at the end of your day, your tummy might be rumbling along with your engine!
